\*\*\*\*\*Our office would like for you to stop the above medications one week before surgery; however, you will need to call your prescribing doctor to find out exactly when they want you to STOP before surgery and when to start after surgery.\*\*\*\*\*

## PREP INSTRUCTIONS: ONE DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE

1) STOP taking METFORMIN (to decrease the risk of a problem called lactic acidosis.)

## 2) You will be on CLEAR LIQUIDS all day long.

- You may have hard candy.
- NO SOLID FOOD.
- Clear Liquids are: Black Coffee, Tea, Soda, all clear Juice, Gatorade, Popsicles, Jell-O, and Beef or Chicken Broth.
- NOTHING RED OR PURPLE IN COLOR
- NO PULP IN JUICE OR POPSICLES

3) FOLLOW THE SUPREP BOWEL PREP KIT INSTRUCTIONS ON THE NEXT PAGE.

# DAY OF COLONOSCOPY:

- You may take **heart**, **lung**, **blood pressure**, **or seizure medicine with THE MORNING SUPREP BOWEL PREP KIT**. PLEASE LET THE NURSE THAT CHECKS YOU IN AT SURGERY KNOW WHICH MEDICINE YOU TOOK TODAY.
- DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING THIS MORNING AFTER YOU FINISH YOUR SUPREP BOWEL PREP KIT

# AFTER THE COLONOSCOPY:

- YOU <u>CANNOT</u> DRIVE YOURSELF HOME. YOU NEED TO HAVE SOMEONE DRIVE YOU HOME. YOU CANNOT TAKE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (BUS, TAXI, UBER ETC)!!!
- Someone should stay with you at least 12 hours after discharge from the hospital.
- On the day of the surgery you should not drive, use heavy machinery, or sign legal documents.

## **INSURANCE INFORMATION:**

- All Insurance will be called by scheduling to ensure date of activation and obtain prior authorization (if required).
- For specific benefit information, including deductible, out of pocket, co-pay, or any other questions regarding insurance coverage, you will need to call the Customer Service Number on the back of your insurance card.
- There will be a separate fee for the hospital or surgery center and for the anesthesia department (for more information about this you will need to contact the billing department at your procedure location)

# SUPREP BOWEL PREP KIT

(sodium sellate, potassium sulfate and magnecium sulfate) Oral Solution (17.5g/3.13g/1.6g) per 6 ounces



The day before your procedure you will be on a clear liquid diet all day. **ABSOLUTELY NO SOLID FOOD!** 

- What you CANNOT do:
- · DO NOT drink milk
- · DO NOT eat or drink anything colored red or purple
- DO NOT drink alcoholic beverages

Any of the following liquids are OK to drink.

- · Water
- · Strained fruit juices (without pulp) including apple, orange, white grape, or white cranberry
- · Limeade or lemonade
- · Coffee or tea (DO NOT use any dairy or non-dairy creamer)
- · Chicken broth
- · Gelatin desserts without added fruit or topping (NO RED OR PURPLE)

#### Note:

- · SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit is indicated for cleansing of the colon as a preparation for colonscopy in adults
- · Be sure to tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit may affect how other medicines work
- · Medication taken by mouth may not be absorbed properly when taken within 1 hour before the start of each dose of SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit
- · The most common adverse reactions after administration of SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit were overall discomfort, abdominal distention, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, and headache
